7th Young Scholars of ScAIEM Workshop

May 8th-9th, 2023 at Mälardalen University, Västerås, Sweden

The aim of the Young Scholars of ScAIEM is to gather doctoral students, post-docs, and other junior researchers from all around the Nordics researching topics related to Industrial Engineering and Management to support their professional development and integration into the academic community. The workshop offers young scholars the possibility to present their research, get feedback from peers, and to create a network in a friendly gathering of fellow young scholars. All research within the field of Industrial Engineering and Management is welcomed. Submissions are accepted from young scholars in ScAIEM member organizations.

Please submit your **abstract by March 31st** to confirm your participation. If you wish to receive written commentary on your work, we ask you to submit your full paper, either in a well-developed or working stage. If you only wish to participate in the discussion and present your work, full paper submission is not required. The work you present can be for example a doctoral dissertation plan, a journal manuscript, a chapter of your thesis etc.

The workshop is 1.5 days and takes place **Monday to Tuesday 8th-9th of May** and will start at Monday 09:00 (CEST) and ends on Tuesday 12:00 (CEST). The workshop is organized by the School of Business, Society and Engineering at **Mälardalen University, Västerås, Sweden**. The workshop format will include presentations of papers, each followed by the comment of a pre-defined opponent and group discussions. Thus, all participants, in addition to active participation in the discussions, will be expected to review and provide feedback on another participant's work. Additionally, we are planning a study visit to an international industrial company, and a dinner for all participants on Monday night. An informal optional dinner, at the participants' own cost, will be arranged at a restaurant in Västerås the day before the workshop.

Reimbursement for travel expenses

There is no workshop or submission fee. In addition, ScAIEM offers reimbursement for travel expenses (i.e., flights, train ticket, hotel). The reimbursement can be granted up to 250* euros and requires attendance in the workshop. The number of applicants that can get reimbursement for their traveling expenses is limited. Application for the reimbursement is sent in connection with abstract submission to the workshop and will be granted by the workshop committee. The reimbursement is paid retrospectively.

- Short abstract (< 1000 words): **March 31st, 2023**
- Full paper (for written commentary): **April 28th, 2023**
